Entrance Tests

Only students who have submitted an online application are eligible to write.

Students wishing to be admitted to St Paul's College have to write an entrance test in English and Mathematics which they are required to pass with **50%** or more to qualify for the next round, the interview stage.

Grade 8 entrance tests will be written on:

Following the completion of the interview stage, the recruitment committee will offer successful candidates a position, while others will be placed on the waiting list. Students who have not achieved the pass mark of 50% will not be called for an interview.

Grade 9, 10 and 11 entrance tests will be written in the 3rd Term of 2019 and details as to the exact date, venue and procedure will be forwarded to all applicants at the beginning of Term 3.
